

### "I Carry Your Heart/ Concrete"

#### **Directions**

- 1. Start: with a gentle grounding and inhale/exhale for five to ten breaths.
- **2.** Read: "I Carry Your Heart With Me" By EE Cummings. Ask the participants to underline any words or phrases that speak to them.
- **3.** Write: Introduce participants to the definition of love. Allow time for students to discuss the different types of love someone may feel or have. For 3–5 minutes, ask students to list as many words as they can think of when they hear the word love (like a list poem). Then, provide a premade sheet with possible love words and invite them to add more to their list.
- 4. Art: Concrete Heart Poem
  - Using a red sheet of card stock and precut pieces of white paper, students will write each love word they've chosen on a slip.
  - Then, arrange the slips into a heart shape (like a concrete poem).

Please bring an example of the art activity to your session—ideally one you've made yourself. A full-color example is included at the end of this document. *If needed, print it elsewhere, as color printing is not permitted on the office printer.* 

#### **Materials**

Red and white card stock, pencils, markers, glitter (optional), liquid glue (if using glitter), stickers (optional).


